I Over 30% of the ice in Pakistan's glaciers has already melted leading to reduced river flows (The Express Tribunes, 2020). The Primary reason for this rapid melting is global warming, which increases temperature, causing glaciers to shrink faster than they can regenerate. To address these challenges, Pakistan has implemented the Global Laki Outburst Flood (GLOF) project under SDG 13, focusing on building early warning system and constructing protective infrastructure to mitigate the risks associated with glacial melt.

II Threats of Biodiversity and Ecosystem - Pakistan's rich biodiversity and ecosystem are under significant threat from global warming. Changes in temperature and precipitation patterns are disrupting natural habitats, leading to the decline of species and the degradation of ecosystem. This is particularly concerning for a country like Pakistan, which relies heavily on its natural resources for livelihood and economic activities. For example, key species such as the snow leopard and Indus River dolphin are losing their habitats due to changing climate conditions (WWF Pakistan, 2021).
